Carronade Capital Master, LP (“Carronade”), together with the other participants in its solicitation, has filed a definitive proxy statement and accompanying **GOLD** universal proxy card with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”) to be used to solicit votes for the election of Carronade’s slate of four director nominees at the 2025 annual meeting of shareholders (the “Annual Meeting”) of Cannae Holdings, Inc., a Nevada corporation (the “Company”). Carronade has filed a supplement to its definitive proxy statement that includes certain additional information on the Annual Meeting.

Item 1: On December 2, 2025, Carronade mailed materials to shareholders of the Company and released certain investor slides, copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 and incorporated herein by reference.

Item 2: Also on December 2, 2025, Diligent published an article, which was posted on Diligent’s website and included the following quote from Carronade:

In a response email sent to DMI, Carronade stated: “Cannae’s ad hominem attacks and deflections attempt to mislead shareholders into supporting the same directors that have destroyed shareholder value by -60% over the past five years while handsomely rewarding themselves with over \$600 million in compensation – yet all three independent proxy advisors agree that Carronade’s nominees warrant election to help bring the independence needed to drive change.”

Source: Diligent. Diligent is not a party to and has not endorsed Carronade’s proxy solicitation and has not consented to use of the article in Carronade’s proxy solicitation.

Item 3: Also on December 2, 2025, Carronade sent a SMS text message blast to shareholders of the Company:
